

Lab 1: Hello World!

All you need to do for this lab is to successfully write, compile, and run a “hello world” program that prints something out to the terminal when its `main()` function is executed.

Make sure that you comment your code, between a `/**` and a `*/` as shown below. The comment should include a description of the program, the names of everyone in your group, and the date.

The class should be called `HelloWorld`, and thus your source code file should be called `HelloWorld.java`.

Your code should look like this:

```
/**
 * A basic "hello world" program.
 *
 * @author (your names)
 * @version (today's date)
 */
public class HelloWorld {
    public static void main(String[] args) {
        System.out.println("Hello world!");
    }
}
```
